TOWN HALL On the High Street (B4040) at the corner of Waylands.
Please note: no smoking inside – and no muddy footwear!

PARKING There are three public car parks in Cricklade, as marked on the map:

- By Stockham Close, on the way in from the A419
- Off the High Street, by the Doctors Surgery
- By the Town Hall, although this will probably fill up early

Otherwise there is plenty of on-street parking, but please be considerate. We suggest you aim to arrive in Cricklade by 10.30. Please check in at the Town Hall by 11.00; bags can be left there for changing after the runs/walk. (You will check in again afterwards – that way we’ll know how many of you we’ve lost... – to collect your ‘glass’ and food & drink vouchers.)

STAYING OVERNIGHT

There are no camp sites within easy walking distance of the town center, but camping may be available at

- Second Chance Touring Park, Marston Meysey
- Hoburne Cotswold Holiday Park, South Cerney
- Cirencester Park Caravan & Motorhome Site, Cirencester

Alternatively, there is accommodation in/closer to Cricklade, eg Cricklade House (hotel); The Red Lion (pub with rooms); The White Hart (pub with rooms); and some (air)B&Bs.

Also, the Swindon Beer Festival takes place at the Steam Museum, near the station, over 24-26 October!

PUBLIC TRANSPORT There is one Sunday bus service between Swindon Bus Station (a short walk from the railway station) and Cricklade, run by Stagecoach:

- 51: the 09.40, arriving 10.02 (and the 11.40/12.02 if you're not planning to run/walk!): it returns at 16.50/17.15 and 18.50/19.15.

TRAINS

The last London/Reading/Didcot Parkway train which SHOULD give you time to catch the 09.40 bus above leaves Paddington at 08.05, arriving Swindon 09.16; the 08.30/09.31 looks a bit tight... Cross Street Cars (01793 232323) operate a taxi service from the station: the Sunday fare to Cricklade is currently £12.
