

# Teq's Whisky Tasting at Hash CAMRA 2019



Continuing from a long series of Hash CAMRA tastings; Tequil'over ("Teq", aka Richard Piercy) is presenting a set of "Low Cost" ( I DIDN'T say CHEAP!) Single Malt Scotch Whiskies, one is a multi-finished Malt Blend.

The objective of the "competition" (if you MUST) is that the partakers say which Scotch they have sampled, and get pissed for 4 quid! (Designated Drivers excluded)

The Whiskies are:

- A: Speyside
- B: Highland
- C: Islay
- D: "Triple Wood"

Partakers are given an answer paper (you may turn them over ... NOW), a "Draft" is available, and is subject to change.

The bottles are randomly marked: 1 to 4.

Partakers can have 1, 2, 3 or 4, samples : each at £1 a dram.

They enter a "Group" depending on the number of samples they have.

They select a sample from one of the four bottles and mark their answer paper with the number of the bottle (1 to 4) and which of the four Whiskies (A to D) they think it is. Partakers will be awarded points, and points mean .... [Prizes]

Winner(s) are those with most correct in their Sample Group; they get a measure of their choice as prize!

Tequil'over's adjudication is FINAL (!!)
